Tatiana was smiling the whole time. She was so grateful for her new glasses. With glasses, her vision improved from a dismal 10% to 100%.

Even though I worked twice as hard as my friends, my grades never got better. ## PAKISTAN

### SURGICAL

Our friend **Zaffar** lives a humble life driving a school bus. Every day he looks forward to seeing happy students jump his bus to go to school. Driving the school bus was the only source of income for his family.

About a year ago, Zaffar started experiencing problems with his vision. His income barely provided enough for his family; he definitely couldn't afford to see a doctor, let alone for the needed surgery.

Because of his diminished sight, they took away his driver's license and his only way to feed his kids. Zaffar was left unemployed, desperate, and with no options. Fortunately, by a stroke of luck he wandered into one of our community screenings and qualified for a free surgery. After cataract surgery, Zaffar was all smiles as he felt an overwhelming sense of relief. **He can provide for his family once again....He has his life back.**

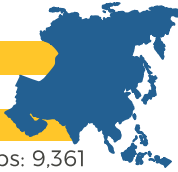
